Bullet Points

- Fiona Coleman attended prior to the start of the meeting to gather councillors views on the proposed artwork to be situated on the roundabout near Aldi
- Concern has been raised over provision of care in Sowerby following the closure of the Lambert. A representative of the CCG has been invited to attend a future meeting to discuss this
- A number of cold callers are visiting the new homes on the Gateway, a programme for no cold calling is run by Trading Standards and they will be invited to attend a Parish meeting
- Cllr Baker has donated funds from his locality budget to the Festival on the Flatts. A donation from Sowerby Parish Council will be considered a future meeting, Cllr Robson has requested the last years accounts to allow an informed decision to be made
- Hambleton owned old style lantern street lights will be fitted with an LED fitment, not replaced. NYCC policy is to replace all old lights with new and the Parish Council would need to pay to retain the original style lights. This will be discussed at a future meeting
- Minutes were shared from the latest Thirsk Town Hall Meeting, a new Caretaker has been appointed
