

Sowerby Parish Council
Ordinary Meeting 14th December 2017
Bullet Points

- Hambleton District Council are looking into the feasibility of purchasing the Lambert Hospital for community use, this is a complicated process and Cllr Robson will update as appropriate and is positive about the outlook.
- Concerns about gritting the bus route from Sowerby towards Dalton were raised, as this road is treacherous in icy weather. Cllr Baker advised that it is a priority 3 route but he will raise this with highways.
- A parishioner raised the issue of the untidy building site at the end of Belgrave Terrace after planning permission was granted for the construction of two dwellings. Cllr Robson advised the resident that the planning decision was made by Hambleton District Council and that any concerns with that process should be directed to them as Sowerby Parish Council are only a consultee in planning matters and do not make decisions. It was agreed that councillors would ensure any issues with the site that could make it dangerous would be reported to Planning Enforcement.
- Parish Noticeboards were discussed, St Oswald's Church are also keen to have a noticeboard presence in the new Gateway development. The clerk will get prices.
- Shine TV are hoping to record a new TV show in the area and will offer a donation to the Parish Councils involved for the benefit of the residents.
- A donation was made to support the work of The Clock Christmas Appeal.
- Sowerby Carol Service will take place around the tree at 7.00pm on Tuesday 19th December, all welcome.
