Bullet Points

- Mr C Snowden was co-opted as a Parish Councillor
- Cllr Baker advised that the final repair to Blakey Bridge is now in the NYCC works programme for 2018/2019 and signage will be reviewed before this
- Surfaces at the play area are being replaced this week and a new seat has been ordered
- The Community Litter Pick will take place on Saturday 7th October
- Discussion took place about the level of affordable housing on the Gateway development. The Parish Council were disappointed with the findings of the Independent District Valuer, agreeing to 0% but acknowledged the provision of 32 bungalows in the third phase. Cllrs Bardon and Robson explained at length the reasoning for this mainly being the escalating cost of the multi junction and other associated Section 106 facilities.
