

Bullet Points from the Ordinary Meeting 8th November 2018

- North Yorkshire Police have advised that investigations are ongoing with regard to the tyre slashing and assault last month
- Ongoing issues with drainage around Sowerby have still not been resolved and the Parish Council have escalated these matters, in conjunction with County Cllr Baker, to a senior member of the Highways Area 2 team
- A meeting had been held with residents of the gateway and Orchid House. There will be a list of comments and action points which will be circulated shortly
- Waste and Dog Waste bins will be purchased for the area around Sowerby Gateway, these will be fitted and emptied by Hambleton District Council
- The Parish Precept has been agreed for 2019/2020 at £70,000
- It was agreed that the CCTV cameras in Sowerby Play Area/Flatts walk need to be updated as soon as possible
- Congratulations were offered to The Clock on securing premises from which to launch its new venture
- Thanks were offered to the Chairman and Cleancore UK for the Cenotaph being cleaned in readiness for Remembrance Sunday
