

MAIN POINTS OF DISCUSSION FROM COUNCIL MEETING ON APRIL 12TH 2012

- **COMMUNICATIONS.**

It was agreed to proceed with creating a new Parish Council website with the facility for social networking, in order to help improve communications with members of the public.

- **NEXT ROUND OF RESURFACING OF GREEN'S ROADS.**

A contract to resurface a section of roadway was awarded to Miles Bainbridge. Residents adjacent to the roadway will be notified prior to work commencing.

- **LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION REVIEW.**

Councillors agreed that as the village had been well represented in the past by two Councillors, they would prefer to have two District Councillors representing the Sowerby Ward.
