- COUNCILLOR VACANCY. The election will take place on 19<sup>th</sup> July. Cllr. Sadler had resigned so there was a further vacancy.
- POTHOLES. Report to County Councillor and Area 2. Last month's reports being dealt with. Limited further funding available.
