- Cllr Bill Austin was re-elected as Chairman and Cllr. Peter Bardon as Vice Chairman.

- The traffic lights have been removed from the road works on the B1448 at Sowerby Gateway. There will be night time closures during the period 31 May to 28th June for resurfacing.
- Work to the new sewage works in Back Lane still being delayed because of drilling problems and will continue until mid June. The road is now open to one way traffic except buses.
- Residents of Cherrygarth who wish to move into Phase One of the new development, Meadowfields, will do so on 27th May. Construction of Phase Two, including the Library, will commence in early June and be completed by Spring 2015.
- New Churchyard extension will be consecrated on 1st June.
- Revised plans for Sowerby Sports Village were well received at a public meeting on 1st May.
