

## **MAIN POINTS FROM MEETING OF SOWERBY PARISH COUNCIL ON 11<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2014**

- Cllr. Robson has been working alongside Area 2 on a temporary plan to prevent large vehicles accessing Blakey Bridge to prevent the frequent damage which causes the closure of the bridge.
- It is hoped that Blakey Bridge will reopen soon once the works have been completed.
- Consultation with the Parish Council regarding Blakey Lane will then take place once the traffic limiting initiative has been in place and its effectiveness has been assessed.
- Thirsk Market Place will have replacement trees and seats during the next month and the flag stones at the rear of the central premises will be re-laid.
- Sowerby Sports Village landscaping and allotments will be the first project to be done once the land is transferred to HDC.
- Vela Homes plan to start work on the extra care facility off Gravel Hole Lane from late September.
- Non-essential grass cutting by NYCC will cease in 2015.
- Broadacres have received an art grant for Sowerby Gateway. A representative from Broadacres will attend the October Parish Council meeting to discuss ideas.
- The next meeting of Sowerby Parish Council will be on October 9<sup>th</sup> 2014.
