

MAIN POINTS FROM MEETING OF SOWERBY PARISH COUNCIL ON 11th JUNE 2015

- A vacancy exists for a Councillor on Sowerby Parish Council and co-option procedures will be advertised. Interest in co-option to be submitted to the Clerk by 26th June 2015.
- Blakey Bridge will be closed during the week 15th -19th June 2015.
- HDC are to consult the public on Recycling. There is a proposal to introduce a third bin in 2016 and the blue bags will then not be needed. The blue box will be for glass recycling.
- Extra Care Housing off Gravel Hole Lane. Show units to open in September.
- Moody Bros have taken over as Builders at The Gateway following the demise of Southdale.
- Reminder that the play area equipment is for young users and not adults. Please use the litter bins or take your rubbish home.
- Residents are urged not to park on pavements. It is illegal and dangerous. Wheel chair users and pram pushers struggle.
- If residents have their own drive please use it to park, to free up roadside areas.
- Swimming Pool Car Park is reserved for users of the Leisure Centre and The Flatts. This ruling is contravened on a regular basis but measures are being taken to enforce the rules.
- Community Projects/Groups and Individuals which in spite of funding cuts have continued to successfully benefit their communities are eligible to enter a NYCC Community Awards Scheme competition.
